### DESCRIPTION

Cartagena has a public network of libraries and other cultural sites located in some of the city's poorest neighborhoods. The network is made up of 13 community libraries, 1 megalibrary, 1 library park, and 3 cultural centers.

Children, teenagers, and elders are in a need of places where they can spend their leisure time in a positive way, yet the libraries are being used less and less because they have limited access to Internet or technology (hardware).

The project seeks to upgrade this infrastructure, both in terms of the current buildings and the available connectivity and educational services offered to the citizens. The key to the success of this upgrading process is to offer IT education (digital environments, Internet access and use, and computer use)

for all ages, free quality Internet connectivity and spaces with comfortable temperatures for children, youth, and elders to spend time in the libraries. The cultural environment of the city is also a great beneficiary of the project.
