DESCRIPTION

This project seeks to rebuild and improve the public buildings in charge of offering legal services and mentoring to women and families in Cartagena. Four different buildings in each of the three counties of Cartagena will include spaces for psychosocial care, childcare, and administrative services from human rights officers. These services have never been properly provided in the city, where infrastructures have always been insufficient and not designed for the specific needs of women, LGBT communities, and children.

The renovation of the three existing buildings and the construction of the fourth will allow us to provide services to a greater number of families and reach a larger part of the population. Furthermore, it can set an example of how the built environment can promote a strong gender perspective.

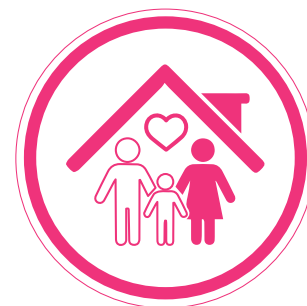
KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS
